Example: Full Day Saturday Trips

1. Eden Project - The Eden Project is a visitor attraction in Cornwall - The complex is made up of adjoining domes that house thousands of plant species. The first dome simulates a tropical environment, and the second a Mediterranean environment.
2. Bath - Bath is a town set in the rolling countryside of southwest England, known for its natural hot springs and 18th-century Georgian architecture.
3. Newquay - Newquay is a seaside resort and fishing port in Cornwall. The resort is widely regarded as the surf capital of the UK.
4. St Ives - St Ives is a seaside town and port in Cornwall.

Example: Afternoon Activities

Plymouth Gin Distillery Tour - Involves a fascinating 40-minute overview of the history of the Distillery as well as an introduction to how Plymouth Gin is made.



National Marine Aquarium
- Visit the UK's largest aquarium attraction and be amazed by the fascinating underwater world.

Indoor Climbing - an increasingly popular form of rock climbing performed on artificial structures that attempt to mimic the experience of outdoor rock.

Try British Traditional cuisine
- such as the famous Fish & Chips or Cream Tea



Wine Tasting session at Royal William Yard - RWY is one of the most important groups of historic military buildings in Britain, it is also the largest collection of Grade 1 listed military buildings in Europe.
